

A short guide on safety signs...



PROHIBITION SIGNS

- Universally recognizable red circle with a diagonal line through it with a black pictogram on a white background.
- Used to prevent people from doing something
- Example: No Entry



MANDATORY SIGNS

- Identifiable by a white symbol or pictogram within a blue circle on a white background
- Displays instructions which must be followed.
- Example: Fire door keep shut



WARNING SIGNS

- Distinctive triangle shape, edged in black with a yellow background and black pictogram.
- Used to alert people to a potential danger or hazard.
- Example: Danger Electric shock risk



EMERGENCY INFORMATION

- Distinguishable by a square or rectangle shape, white pictogram on a green background.
- Indicates the location or direction of an Emergency Escape or First-aid facility.
- Example: Fire Exit Sign



FIRE SAFETY SIGNS

- Square or rectangular in shape, displaying a white pictogram on a red background.
- Used to indicate the location of firefighting equipment, system or control.
- Example: Fire Extinguisher
